How to Connect to the OCT:

To connect to the OCT you need to **map a drive**. Here's how:

Windows 7:

1) **Click on** the Start button on your desktop, then **right-click on** the "Computer" option in the Start menu.

2) Select "Map Network Drive".

3) In the resulting window, **type in** "\\128.151.171.38\ApLabOCT" in the "Folder:" field. **Checkmark the box** "Connect using different credentials", then **click** the "Finish" button.

4) When prompted, **enter** "Zeiss" for the username and the password that you use to log into your account on the OCT (it's on a sticky note on the OCT). The drive should now mount on your computer.

Windows 10:

1) **Click on** the Start button on your desktop, then **scroll down** the list of all programs until you get to "Windows System". **Click on** "Windows System" to display the sub-menu, then **select** "This PC" from the sub-menu.

2) In the resulting window, **click on** "Computer" at the top and then **click on** the "Map Network Drive" icon below it.

3) In the resulting window, **type in** "\\128.151.171.38\ApLabOCT" in the "Folder:" field. **Checkmark the box** "Connect using different credentials", then **click** the "Finish" button.

4) When prompted, **enter** "Zeiss" for the username and the password that you use to log into your account on the OCT (it's on a sticky note on the OCT). The drive should now mount on your computer.
