The Active Perception Lab (PIs: Michele Rucci & Martina Poletti, PhDs) is recruiting subjects for experiments that will investigate the roles of eye movements in visual perception. Each experiment session lasts 1 hour and the number of sessions ranges from 2-5 per week, with a total of 5-10 sessions depending on the experiment.

All experiments will use a Dual Purkinje Image (DPI) eye-tracker; some experiments may also use an electroencephalography (EEG) cap.

You are eligible if you:

- are 18-30 years old
- speak English
- have 20/20 vision with no glasses or contact lenses

Eligible research subjects are paid at an hourly rate.
